THE STAR OF BETHLEHEM

The unfolding of the story of the Incarnation continues today as the Church celebrates the Epiphany. The tale of the magi from the East is one of the most fascinating in all of scripture. It has much to teach us about what we can come to expect, even in circumstances and places that may seem insignificant or small. Bethlehem was a tiny town, what we might refer to today as a town without even one stop light. Yet it is over this seemingly insignificant place that the guiding star stops in its own search for the place where the Savior would be born. Too often we fail to recognize the fact that the star of Bethlehem comes to rest in our everyday lives, where we can experience God's presence, manifested in ever new ways. Epiphany calls us to shake off our stupor and recognize the One who comes to save us.

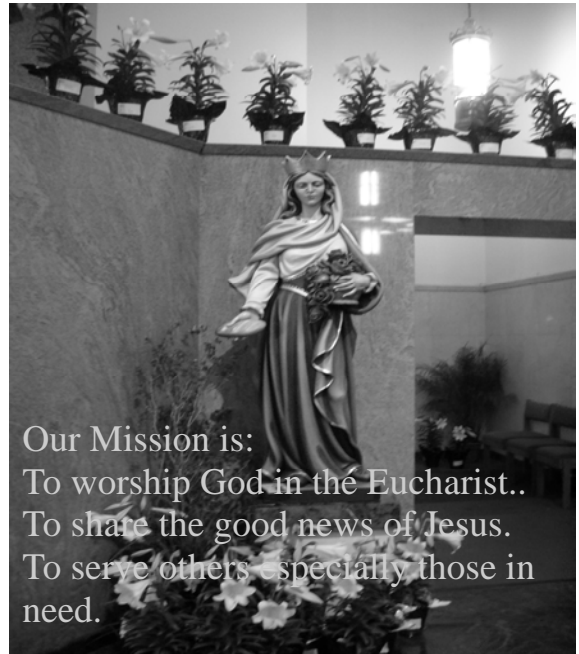
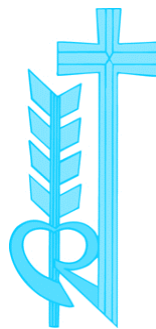

FLU SEASON PROTECTION IN CHURCH

1. You are excused from attending Mass if you are ill with the flu or have reason to believe you have flu-like symptoms.
2. To receive the Precious Blood is optional and you may not receive it during the flu epidemic.
3. Avoid receiving the Host (Body of Christ) on the tongue. Receiving the Host on the hand is more hygienic than receiving it on the tongue.
4. You may avoid using the Holy Water that is in the fonts. The Holy Water in the baptismal font can be used because it is filtered.
5. Do not shake hands at the sign of peace if you have a scratchy throat, coughing or sneezing. You may always choose to bow your head.
6. Wash your hands with soap and water before and after Mass. Ministers and Altar Servers, please use the hand sanitizer in the sacristy.

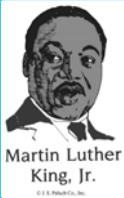

6. Lávese las manos frecuentemente. Los ministros y los servidores del altar usen el liquido higiénico que se encuentra en la sacristía.

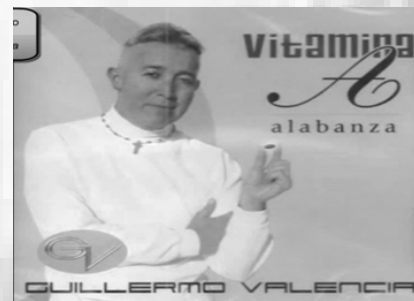
